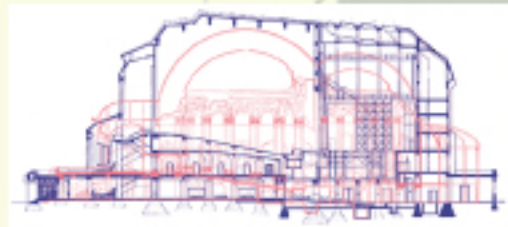

Through the Spiritual Path of the Fool Parzifal's striving demonstrates the spiritual path of the fool. How can we understand and even experience this? Throughout the

conference we will explore this question through the depth and levity of the clown, or court jester. Lecture and workshop content will be reviewed, or played back, in a simple and innocent way – through the heart of the fool! The beauty of the clown is that he works in pure archetype but doesn't "know" anything. He gets it all wrong, like young Parzifal who represents the striving human being. The clown helps us learn through the mistakes so that the soul is freed from the salt of fixed concepts to access ever deeper truths. Through humor the clown acts as a mercurial change agent, guiding us towards the very real and often silly reality of heart thinking.
